Although soil quality benefits of cover crops and manure are typically attributed to additions of organic C, we found no significant treatment effects on SOM content. However, the active, or labile, C fraction, was significantly increased by cover crops and showed good relationships with aggregate stability and microbial biomass.

3. Apply the cover crop with the manure. Some researchers and farmers in the upper Midwest have experimented with mixing cover crops into liquid manure slurries and applying it all in one pass. This seems to work with most cover crops species, except for red clover.

Applying manure in late summer or early fall? Try cover crops

Researchers seeded cover crops into winter-wheat stubble. They attached an AerWay rolling-tine aerator on the rear of a liquid-manure tanker. The aerator poked holes 1/2 to 1 inch deep in the ground. The slurry with the seeds traveled through a rotating chopper-distributor and drop tubes and then into soil fractured by the rotating tines.

Manure is a great nutrient, while cover crops can take up nutrients and keep them from leaching or being lost to mineralization. Research at Iowa State University shows that, when 100 pounds of swine manure were applied into a rye cover crop, nearly 60 pounds of nitrogen were retained in the cover crop, as opposed to manure without a cover crop.

Weymiller used the following four methods of cover crop planting with manure injection on 5- to 20-acre plots, totaling 40 acres: • injected manure, vertical-tilled and then drilled cereal rye seed. • mixed cereal rye seed with liquid manure, and injected manure and seed together.

The roots of the cover crop make the soil surface more permeable so water and manure pollutants are less likely to move over the surface. The top growth reduces runoff, overland flow and erosion. Manure nutrients that infiltrate will be taken up by the cover crop and held over the winter.
