Over 30 years ago, McCauley and Swisher (1984) published an article reviewing the psychometric merit of standardized tests of articulation. Their conclusion was that speech-language pathologists (SLPs) are in the “uncomfortable position” of having less than perfect standardized tests to assess the speech skills of children suspected of having a speech sound disorder (SSD; p. 41).
