The idea of quality of life (QOL) has been discussed in the psychological realm since the 1950s. The Quality of Life Scale (QOLS) originated from John Flanagan, who was an American psychologist (Burckhardt & Anderson, 2003). The Quality of Life Scale measures things like satisfaction, perceptions of control, involvement, commitment, and work-life balance, in terms of one's personal perception.

The scale was developed and standardized to measure perceived work environment. The scale is bilingual in nature and had 46 items on 5 point Likert scale.

The original QWB is relatively long and complex because it has some branching and probe questions and requires a trained interviewer. We therefore developed a self-administered QWB; referred to as the Quality of Well-Being scale, Self-Administered (QWB-SA) that addresses some of these issues (Kaplan, Ganiats, and Sieber, 1996).
